Thank you for contacting the California Innocence Project. According to your prior correspondence with our office, you were convicted of a capital offense and received a death sentence. This means you will eventually be appointed an attorney to represent you in post-conviction proceedings.

Our office has limited resources and typically limits representation to individuals who no longer have a right to an appointed attorney. However, given the gravity of your sentence, we can offer our assistance on a limited basis, but only if it is at the direction of your appointed post-conviction attorney.
