1st, it's been a few months since I last heard from you. You did not respond to any of my correspondence during the above time period.

2nd, MY Notice of Appeal was sent back to the California Supreme Court in January, 1999. (I wrote my declaration on the Notice of Appeal:

"A crime was intentionally perpetrated against me by multi-level of Complicity,
; knowingly & intentionally using all false
; perjured evidence to persecute & dump
me on death row. I wish to do my own
Appeal. I signed off on the Appeal with my
name/signature.")

You are correct when you stated that the
OPD (Office of the Public Defender) was assign-
ed to do my appeal in 2003. At the SANE (OAB)

time, the Judge (who was substituting) acknowledged MY Notice of Appeal by saying; "I did not have a right to represent myself in the (state) Court."

That's why I'm asking the Court for my Notice of Appeal. - If the Court cannot produce my Notices of Appeal - the Court should immediately release me. (Spillman. Arizona v. Youngblood).

Thirdly, it's a saying, "that Sunlight is sometimes the best disinfection". - So, I'm going to continue to share what's going on with my case. (Because my case is a intentional travesty; miscarriage of justice-a sham)

Last, you did not mention the documents I ^{sent} ~~wanted~~ I sent to the California Supreme Court... I also sent you a copy. The "Legal Log book" shows that the document was processed, SCFT (8-8-22). I have no problem with sending them once again. Please let me ^{co.} know.
